(CSEF) Camps, Sports & Excursions Fund

The CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities. If you hold a means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent you may be eligible for CSEF. To be eligible, cards need to be current on 27/1/21 in term one and 19/4/21 for term two.The annual CSEF amount for primary school student is \$125.How to Apply (by 25/6/2021)...

Contact the school office ASAP to obtain a CSEF application form or download from www.educaiton.vic.gov.au/csef. If you applied for the CSEF at this school in 2020 you do not need to complete an application form in 2021 unless there has been a change in your family circumstances. You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- New student enrolments if your child has started or changed schools in 2021 or you did not apply in 2020.
- Changed family circumstances such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing at the school in 2020


