We have a **Curriculum Day planned for Friday March 19**<sup>th</sup>. Our work on that day will centre on the development of Individual Education Plans for all of the children being supported through the DET's Learning Tutor Initiative, and extensive planning for Term 2.

Our **School Athletics** is scheduled for **Wednesday March 24**<sup>th</sup> at Nelson Park. More details will be sent home soon but we'd love you to put it in your diary and join us if you can.

We are very excited to welcome Delsie Lillyst into our school community and Portland School Network as our **Indigenous language Support teacher.** Delsie will be working in our school 1.5 days each fortnight to support us in teaching indigenous language and culture. We are thrilled to have her support and we hope to begin communicating with families in the coming weeks about what we are learning and why – stay tuned!

We will hold a **special assembly on Tuesday afternoon at 3:15** to congratulate our **student leaders, sport captains & Junior School Council for 2021** and present them with their **badges**. You are very welcome to join us.

Now is a great time to remind everyone about the importance of **school attendance**. DET is focussed on supporting every child to attend school and ensuring that families have the resources they need to maximise school attendance. There is a strong correlation between high attendance rates and learning success and wellbeing, so please let us know if there is

anything we can do support your child's attendance. Our School Strategic Plan Goal is to improve student attitudes to attendance from 82% positive responses in 2019 to 91% in 2023. In 2020, we achieved a 95% positive endorsement - so we have already exceeded our target. Our trend data over the past 5 years also shows a huge improvement – we are very grateful for the effort you all make to ensure your children attend school!



Our Positive Education focus for the coming fortnight is Positive Meaning. This means creating a sense of belonging and purpose in our classrooms and ensuring that children are engaged in meaningful learning and work. Positive psychology research has found that this is one of the important pathways to wellbeing and flourishing. We will explore the relationship between being of service to others and having a meaningful life; what we can do to make a difference; and how developing our own sense of voice and agency can give us meaning and enhance our wellbeing. If you would like to explore the idea of meaning and happiness, I encourage you to watch the TED Talk 'There's More to Life than being Happy'

# (CSEF) Camps, Sports & Excursions Fund

The CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities. If you hold a means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent you may be eligible for CSEF. To be eligible, cards need to be current on 27/1/21 in term one and 19/4/21 for term two. The annual CSEF amount for primary school student is \$125.

### How to Apply (by 25/6/2021)

Contact the school office ASAP to obtain a CSEF application form or download from <a href="https://www.educaiton.vic.gov.au/csef">www.educaiton.vic.gov.au/csef</a>. If you applied for the CSEF at this school in 2020 you do not need to complete an application form in 2021 unless there has been a change in your family circumstances. You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- **New student enrolments** if your child has started or changed schools in 2021 or you did not apply in 2020.
- **Changed family circumstances** such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing at the school in 2020


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
