# Principal's Message

We are thrilled to see all our littlest people back at school today; they have returned full of excitement and enthusiasm! They've had a lovely day getting back into the school routine with lots of engaging and creative learning tasks and I'm certain they're enjoying being back in their classes with their classmates.

Thank you yet again for the way you have supported them throughout this latest remote learning program – they have worked hard through a challenging time. We hope this next week back at school will settle them back into a routine so that they are ready for a calm and uninterrupted Term 4.



Below is the latest advice from DET about current arrangements for schools:

The Victorian Government has made announcements in relation to arrangements for schools in regional Victoria.

From Friday 10 September students in Prep to Grade 2, Units 3/4 Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) students and final year Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL) and International Baccalaureate (IB) students will return to face-toface learning.

Parents in regional Victoria who are returning to work will be able to access inhome childminding for primary-school aged children and younger.

The existing remote learning program will continue for our Year 3 – 6 students, with on-site supervision only available for those students who were previously eligible for on-site supervision. No additional students in Grades 3 to 6 will be able to attend on-site.

We will continue to ensure that remaining year levels undertaking remote and flexible learning continue to be well supported.



Key health advice

- School staff and secondary school students aged 12 or older must always wear a face mask indoors and outdoors at school, including when attending an Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) program, unless a lawful exception applies.
- It is recommended that children under 12 years of age and students at primary school wear face masks when at school, or when attending an OHSC program.

The Victorian Department of Health is hosting a live webinar for young people to provide information on COVID-19 vaccines and how to support their mental health. You can join the free webinar on Tuesday 14 September, 6-7pm. Registration is via this <u>link</u>.

Topics covered include:

- Vaccines, development and safety
- Accessing and consenting to a vaccination
- How to book an appointment
- How to support your mental health
- Q+A with the panel.

This event will be held via Microsoft Teams Live. For access information visit Attend a live event in Teams.

The current guidelines have stated that **no camps, excursions or incursions can be conducted at this stage.** Our School Council has decided that the Year 5/6 Sovereign Hill camp planned for next term will be cancelled and an alternative program will be developed in alignment with whatever restrictions are in place at the proposed time. More details will be communicated next term.

School gatherings, assemblies and non-essential meetings should be deferred.

COVID-safe restrictions remain in place:


- Visitors onsite are limited to essential school services and operations

For our inquiry we have been studying local endangered and threatened animals. We worked in pairs to research and write a report on our animal. Once our reports were finished they were published into a special book.



Here are some of our students exploring robotics and computer sciences.











