NAPLAN will be completed on May 10^{th,} 11th and 13th. This year all components are completed online, with the exception of Year 3 Writing. We have some additional flexibility in when the tests must be completed this year, so we are able to schedule times that we think work best. We

have an additional week to make sure that any children who missed an assessment in the first week, can complete them from May 16th – 19th. It is the expectation that all children deemed able to complete the assessments should do so. A special request for families; it has become very common for children to bring precious items and toys to school. There are many reasons why this has become problematic. Firstly, while we do our best to keep everyone's items safe, unfortunately things do go missing, get lost or broken, which children obviously find distressing. We feel that this distress could be easily avoided if children didn't bring their precious things to school. Secondly, many of these precious items and toys are causing children to become very distracted from their learning; again, a distraction that could be easily avoided if children didn't have toys etc at school. We would really appreciate your support in helping us manage this issue by not allowing your children to bring precious items and toys to school.

We have another **Curriculum Day planned for May 20th.** We will continue our work with Bronwyn Ryrie -Jones on Responsive Teaching, effective assessment, feedback and goal setting. **No children will attend school on this day.**

Following the agreement of the Australian Education Union's EBA negotiations, Professional Practice Days (PPDs) have been re-allocated to schools this term. We have selected **May 31**st as **our PPD**, during which we will collaborate to collate and moderate various assessment in preparation for the mid-year reports. *No children will attend school on this day.*


