We successfully navigated the online **NAPLAN** assessments over the past two weeks, and we look forward to receiving the results in time to reflect on our progress and achievements, and to identify further opportunities for improvement. On behalf of the school community, I want to thank Hayley Jones for the time and effort she put into ensuring our students had a relatively calm, stress-free experience. I also want to thank the children's teachers for the time and effort they put into preparing the children, so they felt comfortable and confident with the process.

I also want to **thank Hayley for her organisation of the Book Fair.** As always, the children love this opportunity to shop for great reading material and we hope it promotes a love of reading for your children and family.

We have started our **2023 Prep tours**, and it is always a lovely time to reflect on our successes as a school and share all our strengths and achievements. Please encourage families who are in the process of selecting a school to make an appointment and take a tour, and if you have children beginning school next year, now is the time to collect enrolment forms.

We are also about to begin the annual **Student Attitudes to School Survey (AtoSS).** We always use the data collected from our Years 4 – 6 children to reflect on strengths and achievements and identify areas for further improvement. Our data over the last two years has been extremely positive and I always enjoy this opportunity to spend dedicated time to talk with children about their perceptions, what is going well for them and what we could do better. Congratulations to Lily Johnstone, Koby Cracknell and Darcy King who all represented our school at the regional cross-country event on Monday. We really admire and appreciate the positive and enthusiastic way in which they participated in the event – we're very proud of their effort and how hard they tried. Well done!

We had the **school photos done yesterday,** however there were about a dozen children absent for various reasons. Our photographers will return to school at a later date to make sure everyone's photo is taken, and they are included in their class photos. We will let you know in advance when the return date is confirmed.



We continue to have a wellbeing **focus for Positive Education** each fortnight. We are currently focusing on **positive relationships**, particularly on exploring how emotions such as empathy and compassion can influence our behaviour and our relationships. Being able to appreciate and consider the feelings of others and having empathy and compassion for the perceptions and perspectives of others, is integral to the development of positive relationships, and is sometimes a skill that little people can find a challenge.

We have two teams of children attending the **English Games Day** at Heywood & District Secondary College on Friday. These events are a great way for children to mix with and get to know children from other schools, and to celebrate and use their skills. We wish them lots of fun and success!

Please remember that Tuesday 31st of May is a student free day. This is an additional professional practice day for our teachers, who will use the time to gather and moderate their assessment data in preparation for reports later in the term.

Cross Country report



Junior School Showcase


