



Principal's Message...

Welcome back everyone – we hope you all had a lovely break from the routines of school and are looking forward to another productive term of learning. As always, Term 4 is a very busy term, starting with the mini fete on October 21st, Year 5/6 camp to Canberra, Prep and Year 6 transitions, the school concert, end of year excursions and Year 6 Graduation. **Please make sure you check the newsletter each fortnight for dates and detailed information about each event as it arises.** We have our fingers crossed that the challenges and disruptions caused by COVID are behind us and we can return to strengthening our school community and working together to create a positive learning environment for our children.

Parents Club are meeting this afternoon at 3:35 to begin planning for ongoing and future school events. Everyone is welcome to join us.

As I've already communicated, the **mini fete has been rescheduled for October 21**st due to the predicted poor weather tomorrow. The Year 5/6 children are working very hard to get ready for all their stalls and activities – the level of excitement is building! We have been posting detailed information on Facebook for those of you who are new to the mini fete, so you know what to expect. We will also be spending some time with all of the children to learn about shopping with cash, how to pay and receive change, what is good value for money – it's a great learning opportunity for all of the children.

At the end of last term, we advised parents that the **Year 3 and Year 5 NAPLAN** results were available for parents at pick up at the office. A rather large number of results have yet to be picked up, so I encourage you to come in and collect them, or call the office to arrange for them to be sent home. Your child's NAPLAN results can provide you with a snapshot of how they are progressing, where their strengths and areas for improvement are, and may be useful when applying for transition to secondary school.

We are about to **begin our 2023 Prep and Year 6 Transition programs**. Please make sure we have all your information so we can communicate effectively about events, dates, and times. We look forward to welcoming our new group of Preps into the school and supporting our Year 6's as they move into this next phase of their educational journey.

We are also about to begin the process of structuring and creating classes for 2023. As always, I invite you to meet with me to discuss your child's placement for 2023. Please call the office to book a meeting with me prior to November 18th.

I am also about to meet with all the children to do a review and refresh of our school's expectations about behaviour, learning and the way children interact with each other. At the end of our review, I will send all families a document which outlines our expectations and the ways in which those expectations will be implemented and managed. If you would like to discuss this process and its outcome with me, you are very welcome, and I encourage you to do so; working in partnership with families is essential to creating a cohesive culture of high expectations.
