Principal's Message...

Thank you to those parents who have made time to come and chat with me about their child's needs for 2023. We will ask the children to consider who they would like to share a class with next week, and then commence the construction of 2023 classes the following week. If you there is something you think we need to know about classes for next year, please make a time to see me in the coming week.

We had an **amazingly successful fete;** the Year 5 and 6 children did a wonderful job planning a great day for everyone! **Thank you so much to the teachers** who also worked extremely hard to make sure everything came together – I know they were exhausted but extremely pleased with the fete itself, how everyone enjoyed themselves, and how very well supported it was by the whole school community. The children **raised almost \$4500 (after expenses)** which has allowed us to subsidise their camp by \$60 each, as well as give us an expenses buffer for next year's fete. We would also like to offer our appreciation to **all those people who donated items and prizes**, and who helped during the day. A very special thank you to our newly invigorated **Parents Club** who also helped so much throughout the day – it is so good having a dedicated and enthusiastic group of parents to support the children and encourage participation in our school community.

Our Parents Club will continue to play a key role in engaging families in our community. This term they will help us welcome and connect with our 2023 prep children and their families. They will help with Graduation, donating a photobooth so the children can capture their last, joyful moments of Year 6, and conduct our Christmas Raffle to add to our fundraising efforts for playground development. We would love to welcome more members into Parents Club in 2023!

Thank you to the many families who have paid their school fees this year. As always, we really appreciate your financial contribution which makes such a difference to the learning experiences we can provide for the children. This year, like everyone, we have experienced increasing costs in the kitchen, which makes it more expensive to produce the meal each week for our Stephanie Alexander Kitchen Garden Program. If you have not yet paid the SAKGP levy, we would really appreciate it if you could do so now, so we can continue to provide a lovely meal each week for the children to enjoy!

The children are enjoying their current inquiry into community, democracy, and our system of government. The Year 5 and 6 children are particularly interested as they prepare for their **coming trip to Canberra**. While it is a very long drive, with the entire week spent in the National Capital, we believe it is an important experience for them, and one which many will never repeat. They will attend many of the iconic venues, including:

- The National Capital Exhibition
- The National Museum
- Parliament House including the students observing the House of Representatives sitting, and participating in a role play debating a bill
- Old Parliament House and the Museum of Australian Democracy including the electoral processes for voting in the House of
 Representatives-
- The National Film and Sound Archives
- A tour of the Embassies, the National gallery, the High Court of Australia, the Royal Mint,
- A visit to the Australian War Memorial
- A visit to Questacon Science house





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As you can see, they are all going to be very busy – I'm sure they will arrive home exhausted but having had an amazing time! A big thank you to Hayley Jones, Tom Englezos, Dylan Jennings, Jodie Nash and Lauren Yuill for accompanying the children on their epic tour, and for giving up their personal time to provide this wonderful opportunity for the children – without adults who are willing to give up their time, to be on duty 24/7 for 5 very long days, camps would not be able to happen – so enormous appreciation in advance!
